



Emergency Airway Management Course (EAMC)

Practical skill stations of various scenarios comprising of normal endotracheal intubation, tips and tricks, rapid sequence intubation, awake intubation, difficult & failed airway & paediatric airway management.

Hands-on practice using the bougie, LMA, videolaryngoscopes , surgical cricothyroidotomy, mechanical ventilators and noninvasive mechanical ventilators.
